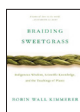

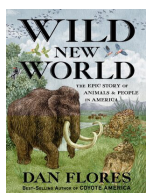

4. Readers enjoy the title and share their thoughts through the online discussion board at BigLibraryRead.com and across other channels in communities around the world.

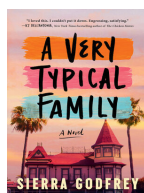

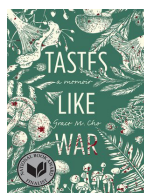

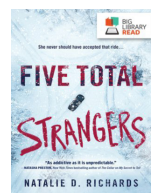
